VMware® Lifecycle Manager (LCM) enables IT professionals to manage virtual machines by automating standard IT processes used during a virtual machine's lifecycle. From requests for virtual machines to decommissioning, VMware Lifecycle Manager automates workflows required to manage virtual machines in a large-scale environment. This reduces the complexity of managing virtual machine, and enables IT to align management of virtual machines with their existing business procedures.
