- Proof-of-concept environment installed and configured.

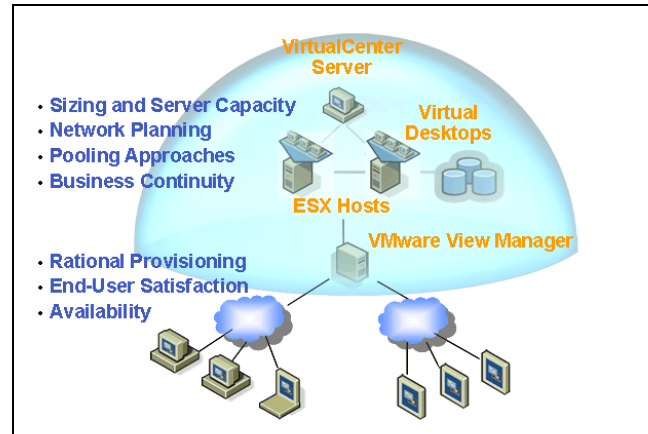
Target Audience
