Overview

This consulting engagement provides best practice scenarios to upgrade from VMware® ESX™ 2.x and optionally from VMware VirtualCenter Server 1.x to VMware Infrastructure 3, which includes both components. The workshop provides an understanding of the resources and steps required to determine the upgrade path best suited to your environment.

- On-site upgrade using your own supported server hardware for up to two non-production VMware ESX 2.x hosts and one VirtualCenter 1.x Management Agent
- Configuration analysis report based on the Virtual Infrastructure Audit toolkit
